

Reinsurance Reporting Requirements*

The following losses should be reported within 48 hours of notice of the injury.

1. Any spinal cord injury
2. Any serious head injury
 - a. Including skull fracture
 - b. Brain injuries
 - c. Loss of sight of both eyes
3. Amputation of any major extremity
4. Any 3rd degree burns on 40% or more of the body
5. Fatalities

The following losses should be reported as soon as the exposure is identified.

1. Losses projected to be in excess of 50% of retention
